Parent Confidence Growth

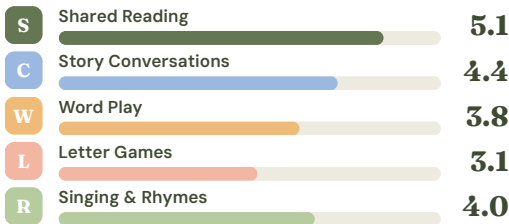

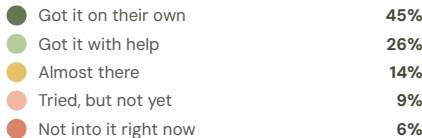
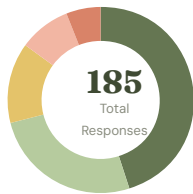
